A REMINDER ABOUT REBROADCAST ETIQUETTE FOR BPC RECORDINGS

Just a note to say we are flattered that some of our BPC recordings are going to be seen and heard again on other music club programs. It's great when the artistry of our members can be appreciated more widely. There are a few rules to follow in these situations.

Usage terms from the Board: Virtual performances (YouTube recordings) are the property of the performers, and performers must give advance permission for their recording to be used in another venue (for example, another music club's online program). Also, when performances were recorded or produced by the Piano Club, a production credit should be given. For example: "Music recording courtesy of the Berkeley Piano Club." Finally, as a courtesy, even after the performer has given permission, please notify Nora Adachi.

Technical note: Our music recordings are "unlisted" on YouTube (meaning that the general public cannot search YouTube and find them). But a member or guest viewing one of our programs can use the share button to copy the YouTube link to the performance and share the link with others or embed in another program.
